Future work skills in hearing aid acoustics

Today is the slowest day of the rest of our lives!

Through digitisation, the use of quantum computers, and artificial intelligences, we will experience more changes in the next five years than in the past 100 years. The world is constantly changing, and the profession of hearing aid acousticians will also be affected.

Dennis Fischer believes that, in the future, it will be HI rather than AI that matters most. Human intelligence will therefore become more important than AI. When machines take over all routine mental and physical tasks, there will once again be more time for us humans to provide individual care and advice, and conduct intensive conversations. Competencies such as empathy, resilience, and good self-management will be essential for running a successful hearing care business in the future.
